They cared about the Colorado Springs community and developed many of our local attractions, inspiring people from all over the world to visit Colorado Springs.



Throughout this activity book you will find coloring pages and activities that reflect the lives and history of the Penroses.






Decorate the Carriage for the Carnival!



Cheyenne Mountain Zoo Coloring Page




Tessie the elephant arrived in Colorado Springs in April of 1926 and was renowned for her "golf caddy" skills at The Broadmoor hotel.

Will Rogers Shrine of the Sun Spot the Difference!




Will Rogers Shrine of the Sun was built in 1937, just above Cheyenne Mountain Zoo.




